



WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP RAPID 2014

World Championship Turkish Draughts

Rules & Regulations

1. The organization of the World Championship Rapid 2014 has been allotted by the FMJD to the Turkish Draughts Federation (TDF) and will take place from Wednesday, October 22nd till Friday, October 24th.

2. At the same period the 1st World Championship Turkish Draughts will be played. Technical details will be announced by TDF separately.

3. General schedule:

(a) October 21st

⇒ 20:00 Technical meeting (checking players list)

(b) October 22nd

⇒ 08:00 - 09:00 Reception (last applications)

⇒ 10:00 Opening Ceremony

⇒ 11:30 WC Rapid rounds I-III

⇒ 15:30 WC Turkish Draughts rounds I-III

(c) October 23rd

⇒ 10:00 WC Rapid rounds IV-VI

⇒ 15:00 WC Turkish Draughts rounds IV-VI

(d) October 24th

⇒ 10:00 WC Rapid rounds VII-IX

⇒ 15:00 WC Turkish Draughts rounds VII-IX

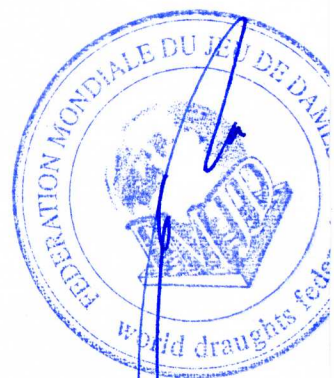
⇒ 20:00 Closing ceremony

(e) October 25th

⇒ (after breakfast) Departure

4. Participants. Tournament is open for each player who accepts these rules & regulations.

6. Official titles:

- (a) World Champion Rapid
- (b) World Champion Rapid National Teams
- (c) World Champion Turkish Draughts

7. System of competition:

(a) World Championship Rapid:

- ⇒ Game rate: 15' + 5"
- ⇒ Tournament will be played in Swiss system, 9 rounds.
- ⇒ Only in case of all criteria of challengers for 1st 3 places will be equal, a tie break should be played (2 games 5'+3" and if the tie break ends in a draw, than GL tie break with 3'+2" will be played). If more than two players need to play tie break than one game 5'+3" will be played during the tie break tournament.
- ⇒ All rules concerning rapid games and rights – duties of players/referees described in FMJD annexes are valid.

(b) World Championship Rapid National Teams:

- ⇒ Before the tournament each federation announced up to 5 players as a member of national team.
- ⇒ Team classification will be settled up based on results of 3 best members of national team:
 - i. Lowest sum of places
 - ii. if equal – highest sum of points
 - iii. if equal – higher place of best team player decides
- ⇒ For teams with less than 3 players N+1 to the score will be added for absent players, where N=number of participants in the tournament.

(c) World Championship Turkish Draughts:

- ⇒ Game rate: 45'
- ⇒ Tournament will be played in Swiss system, 9 rounds.
- ⇒ Other details will be defined by TDF separately

8. Competition fee is **100€**. This should be paid to FMJD before October 10th

Competition fee paid by cash before tournament is **120€**.

Competition fee for Turkish players is **60€**.

Competition fee gives rights to play in both championship.



9. Any protest to Jury d'Appel should be given in written form (in English) to the main referee not later than 10 minutes after the game. Each protest is valid only after paying a deposit of 100 euro. The deposit will be returned only if a protest will be accepted.

10. Accommodation

- (a) Official package: from the dinner October 21st till Breakfast October 25th with hotel room (2-3 persons), breakfast, lunch, dinner and access to all hotel facilities (swimming pool, gym,...) except massages.
- (b) Official package is free for up to 3 players from each federation without debt to the FMJD (including 2014 membership fee) but only valid for players who will play in BOTH – rapid and Turkish draughts championship. The federation has to inform the FMJD which of their players use this special package.
- (c) For other players/coaches and also accompanying persons, official packages costs 200€ per person (**50€ per day**) and should be paid at the tournament reception.
- (d) Additional days before/after the event costs 50€ per person per day (with breakfast, lunch, dinner)

13. Prize money for World Championships is **€12,000** (net of any tax) will be divided as follows:

(a) Prize money World Championship Rapid :

⇒ 5 th place	400 €
⇒ 6 th place	350 €

⇒ 10 th place	250 €
⇒ 11 th place	200 €
⇒ 12 th place	200 €
⇒ 13 th place	150 €

14. Additional prizes (electronic equipment) will be given to the best in the following sub-categories:

- (a) Best player with FMJD rating 2100-2199
- (b) Best player with FMJD rating 2000-2099
- (c) Best player with FMJD rating below 2000
- (d) Best female player
- (e) Best Turkish players

15. In the case of something not being clear in the FMJD regulations or in this regulation, the decision will be made by the main referee in consultation with the organization and the FMJD tournament director.
