

11. Right for the World Title Match

If the ex-champion has lost his title in the tournament for the World Championship, he has the right to challenge the new champion to a World Title Match.

If the ex-champion has retained his title in the World Championship tournament, the player ended on the second place in the World Championship has the right to challenge the

current World Champion to a World Title Match.

When a world title match cannot be played the World Champion keeps his title but does not have the right for a title match two years later. Then this right for a title match goes to the numbers 1 and 2 of the World Championship tournament.

When the conditions for the world title match are acceptable for the FMJD Executive Council the players have the obligation to play (unless they come with a better possibility).

If one of them does not accept the conditions a reserve may take his place. The reserve is the next player from the last World Championship tournament.
