European Students Championship 2015

1. The organization of the European Students Championship 2015 has been allotted by the EDC to the Bulgarian Draughts Federation. The championship will be held on September, 20 - 27 at the Resort Sunny Beach – <http://www.sunny-beach.com/>

Place: Hotel Regattapalace -<http://www.hotelregattapalace.com/>

All participants have to stay at the hotel provided by organizers. All participants must have a medical insurance for the period of competition.

Schedule:

Arriving days → September, 19

Sept, 20 at 16.00 technical meeting and 1st round

Sept, 20-27 competition days

Sept, 27 at 15.00 - last round

Closing → September, 27 around 19.00

Departure → September, 27-28

The tournament will be supervised by main referee Kristi Promet.

2. There are following 2 championships will be played (separately for boys and girls):

2.1. Students boys – players born 1st of January 1989 or later;

2.2. Students girls – players born 1st of January 1989 or later.

3. Only members of European national federations affiliated to the FMJD can participate. Players must have the citizenship of the Federation they represent or be members of this federation according to FMJD rules. EDC has the right to invite some players from new countries (never been members of FMJD).

4. There are no limits of number of players from one federation.

5. The players must be students (university, institute, college, academy etc.) and have supporting document.

6. Applications only from national federations should be sent at latest August, 31 by e-mail registration@europedraughts.org and shashki@abv.bg contain the list of players with full names, surnames, dates of birth and universities (institutes, colleges, academies etc.). In case of any problems the national federation should contact EDC directly.

7. Before the beginning of the Championship a preliminary meeting will be held by the Chief Referee who will expound the present regulations to players.

8. Depending on the Chief Referee decision Swiss or round robin tournaments will be played. In case of unequal number of participants in some tournaments other tournaments' systems can be used according the Chief Referee decision in consultation with EDC official representative. Chief Referee has the right to determine, that players from the same university (institute, college, academy etc.) or national federation have not to play between each other in a few last rounds depending on tournaments system and number of participants.

9. Time control 80' + 1' per move (Fisher system).

10. Final places determine according FMJD rules applying to corresponding tournaments system.

Barrages should not be played. Only in case of all criteria of challengers for champion's title will be an equal, barrage should be played (2 games with the time control 5' + 3" per move (Fisher system) and if champion will not specified, then – games with time control 3' + 2" per move till the first winning). Details will be announced by a Chief Referee after the consultations with EDC official representative.

11. Prizes:

11.1. medals for the 3 first places (including Blitz Championship)

11.2. cups for the winners, including Blitz Champions

12. Financial conditions

12.1. Inscription fee is 20 euro for each player;

12.2. Inscription fee in blitz championship is 10 euro for each player;

13. Fees can be paid in cash before opening ceremony.

14. All costs for travel and visa expenses as well as travelling, food and lodging and visa expenses for players and accompanying persons have to be paid by their national federations or by themselves.

Prices (hotel + 3 times meal):

- one person in double room 27 eur/per day
- one person in single room 37 eur/per day
